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## **ORIGIN**

Christy Memorial School & College is a co-educational, English-medium Institution affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE Board). This school is established in memory of Mr. Himanshu Vinod Lal (Christy) son of Mr. Vinod B. Lal and Dr. (Mrs.) Shanti V. Lal in the year 2014 at Hathigan Purwakhas, Naini, Allahabad. Himanshu was a young boy of 22 years, pursuing B.Sc. (AG) final Years (SHIATS). He always had a great urge to support needy children and this school was his dream project.

## **AIM**

Christy Memorial School & College is an English Medium Institution, and hence all efforts are made to impart teaching and learning through the medium of English language. Study of Hindi, Sanskrit, Indian Culture and heritage however, occupies an important place in the school's curriculum.

## **ACTIVITIES**

The School's curriculum and the system of evaluation are based on the CBSE Board. In addition, moral education, daily prayers in assembly etc. form an important part of education programme for inculcation of moral values and interest in religion in the students. Games, extra curricular activities and a large play field provide enough opportunities to the students for utilizing their energy constructively toward their physical growth.

## **RULES FOR DISCIPLINE**

1. Every student should carry with him, daily his school diary.
2. The School will not be responsible for goods lost. We discourage children for bringing any expensive article to school.
3. Parents are requested to see that their children are regular, punctual, neat and observe the school discipline.
4. Parents /guardians are not permitted to see their wards or teachers during teaching time.
5. Every pupil must take part in all school activities (physical or cultural) and converse in English in order to gain fluency.
6. Any child who comes to school late or not in proper uniform will be liable to punishment and will be sent back home.
7. In case of sickness if a child has been sent to school, the child will be sent back and parents will have to bear the transport charges.
8. No child will be allowed to go home during school hours other than exceptional circumstances.
9. No child is permitted to buy eatables or titts-bits from anyone who has not been given permission to sell by the school authority.
10. Student will wear identity card with the school uniform every day.



## REGISTRATION

Admission can be obtained by registration on payment of Rs 200/- (not refundable non adjustable).  
It must be noted that registration provides no guarantee for admission, registration should be done on or before the expiry on the date fixed by the school for the year.

## ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL

1. Admission will depend on the performance of the students as judged on the basis of an admission test/interview.
2. The pupils will be tested on the syllabus of the class below the one for which they seek admission.
3. Admission is confirmed only on producing the transfer certificate duly countersigned by the education authority of the previous district and Nagar Nigam Birth Certificate in case of admission in Nursery class.
4. Latest progress report from the previous school should be produced for admission to classes LKG & above.
5. Admission will be strictly on merit.
6. Nagar Nigam Municipal birth certificate will have to be submitted for admission of a child who has not attended any recognized school previously.
7. Special attention must be paid in entering correctly the name and date of birth of the child. Subsequent change in the date of birth or name is not permitted later.
8. Application for transfer certificate must be made in the name of Principal. A clear calendar month's notice for withdrawal from school must be given. If a child is withdrawn without notice one instalment fee will be charged in lieu of notice.

## LEAVE

Application for leaves should be sent to the Principal. If the student is absent without leave for more than 15 days, the name will be automatically struck off the roll.

## PROMOTION

1. A pupil must pass in all the subjects promotion to next class will be decided by the promotion committee which will be final.
2. It is compulsory to pass in English, Maths & Science.
3. The passing marks in a subject is 33%
4. Promotion of student from one class to another is determined on the basis of the terminal and periodical assessments.
5. No leave of any kind would be granted during examination.
6. No Medical certificate etc would be accepted during examination.
7. Student who fails to appear for any exam will be marked absent and no promotion to next class could be granted.

8. If a child is absent for an examination or test he/she will be marked absent and will get a zero no retest will be possible.
9. The result declared at the end of the year is final and will not be reconsidered.
10. Less than 75% attendance will mean detention from final examination.

## RULES FOR THE PAYMENT OF FEES

Fee may be deposited in the school from **01st to 15th day** of every month at the school office without payment of fine. A properly signed and stamped receipt should be obtained after payment of cash. The teacher's copy should be immediately sent to the class teacher. i.e. every month starting from April to March.

**Late fee of Rs. 100/- per month will be charged after 15th of every date.**

## SCHOOL DIARY

1. Every pupil must possess a school diary, which should be brought to school every day.
2. The personal data must be filled by the parents correctly and legibly.

**Friday (Boys)** - I-XII House T-shirt with school logo, White long pants, Blue and white striped Belt with school buckle, White socks, White canvas shoes.

**Saturday (Boys)** - I-XII House T-shirt with school logo, Blue Lower, White Socks, White Canvas Shoes.

**Nursery to V (Girls)** - Check shirt, blue skirt, blue and white striped belt with school buckle, blue socks and black school shoes.

**VI-XII (Girls)** - Checked Kurta, Blue salwar, Blue Dupatta with school logo, blue socks and black school shoes.

**Friday I-V (Girls)** - House T-Shirt, White skirt, School belt, White socks, White Canvas Shoes.

### **NOTICE FOR PARENTS :**

## CMSC students make school proud by winning medals

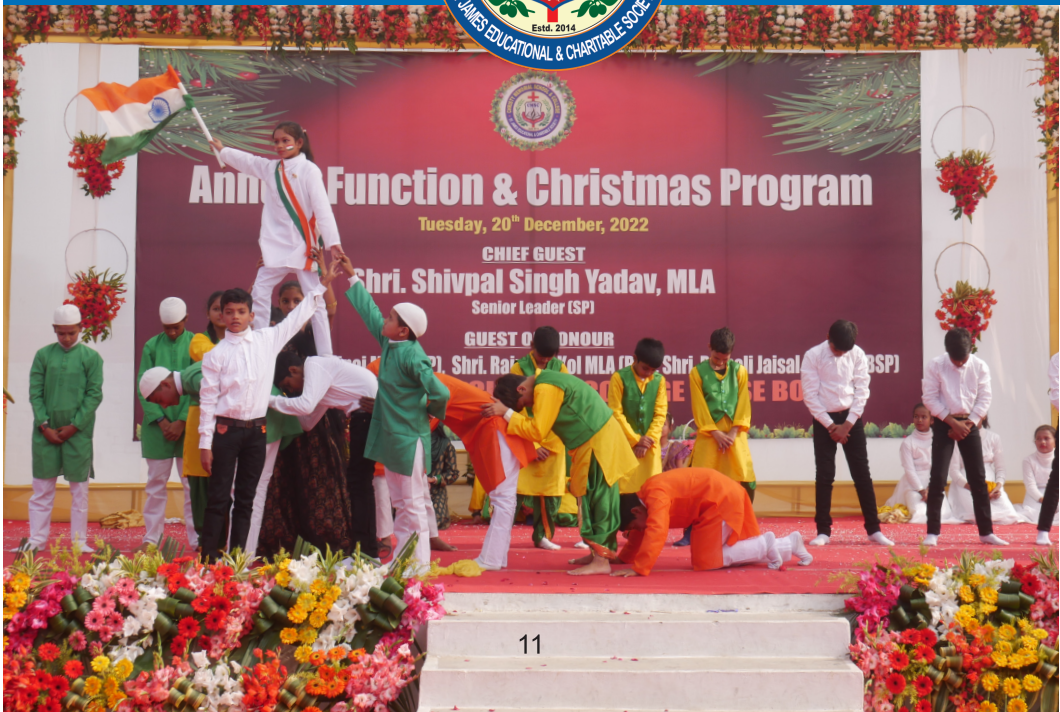
### Principal Neha Pitambar gets Ideal Principal Award
